#### Training Sessions, tailored programmes and progression.

All practice sessions are supported by coaches. Individuals have an option of generalised coaching support or to have an allocated coach. Many use coaches eye video analysis and are familiar with the AGB Drills & Skills routines. We hire in a range of specialists from Sports Psychology to Fitness & Conditioning & run many focused workshops. We run well established Improvers Courses, working with individuals to produce a development plan and then work on agreed improvements. When these workshops are advertised they are usually fully subscribed within the hour!

We pride ourselves in the quality of our coaching support and the diversity and technical depth of our coaches to provide a pathway from beginner to Performance archer. This applies to all bow types, ages & experience. We set up mock competitions particularly to get head-to-head practice. If we are unsure then we will find external help, more recently we now have many archers from other clubs asking for our support!
