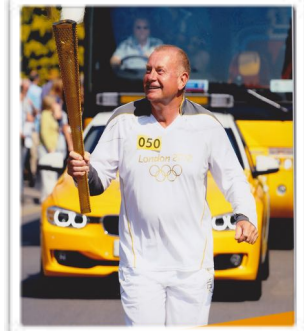
Major Grants
