Membership fees are in two parts;

Archery GB (which covers services, insurance etc) and the club fee.

Annual Club Membership - our fee is just £15, however new members will also need to pay a one off joining fee of £20.

This is to recognise the considerable amount of work existing members have already contributed to the development of our facilities. This fee is reduced where family units join the club. Please ask.

Target Fees - This fee is in place to allow us to run so many sessions every week and cover costs such as target faces, bosses, marking paint/tape and for the six winter season months the cost of hiring five indoor venues! On your first attendance during a given week then you pay a target fee of £3:50 (reduces if more than one family member) any additional attendances during that week there is no further charge! So you could attend five times or more for just £3:50, a big encouragement to attend more than once! You can further reduce the cost if you pay monthly by Standing Order!



Archery GB Membership - which covers services, insurance etc

If joining from 1st Oct, Annual Archery GB fees would currently be:

Senior (age 25+) = £59

Senior (age 18 to 24) = £24:50

Juniors (Under 18) = £12:50

Disability (All categories) = £10:50

Note: Club joining fee is additional to these and fees may reduce depending on time of year.

How to join our Club?

You will need to: Complete a beginners course or provide evidence that you have completed one.

The Club sub-contacts most of its group beginners courses to Xperience Archery, they are very skilled at delivering the courses and will be supported by a number of other Deer Park Archers coaches. The cost is just £40/person for six one hour sessions.

Xperience Archery also deliver individual/family courses on dates and durations to suit but the cost will be extra.

Reduced duration beginners courses may be applicable if individuals have attended Satellite, School or Community Clubs on a regular basis, this would be decided following a recommendation from the relevant coaches and a needs analysis to ensure all the required elements have been met.

As a policy existing Archery GB members applying to the club for membership would be asked to attend an informal assessment. This ensures that the individual is aware of the correct procedures and is not a danger to themselves or others shooting, it is not a test of ability.



Follow up is important - For those completing group beginners courses we offer Improvers courses immediately after to provide the best support to integrate into the club. Group Improvers courses are also advertised within the club for those who joined in other ways and existing members looking to improve.
